

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Students who participate in College or Foundation-sponsored travel are expected to display conduct which will reflect well on the image of the College. As a representative of the College, students are in a position to present the college in either a positive or negative way. The purpose of this document is to clearly define the expected code of conduct to be displayed by students on any outing which the College sponsors as a part of its educational process.

Absolutes

Violations of any of the following codes of conduct could lead to disciplinary action which could lead to expulsion from the College.

1. The Student Code of Conduct, as prescribed in the Student Handbook, is to be followed at all times.
2. No under age drinking.
3. No drinking to excess.
4. No use of illegal narcotics.
5. No unauthorized sharing of College or Foundation-paid hotel rooms.

Other Guidelines for Travel:

1. Travel with others. Venturing out by oneself invites danger.
2. Keep others informed. For security reasons, let others know whereabouts. Leave word at the front desk of the hotel, with the chaperone or with somebody from your group as to your activities.
3. Keep valuables in safe place. They could be locked in the hotel safe.
4. Be on time. Do not keep the group waiting.
5. Do not charge anything to room accounts that are to be paid by the College. Hotels charge for use of telephones, in-room movies, laundry and other ancillary service.
6. Provide the chaperone with special dietary needs or medical information prior the trip.
7. Have an enjoyable time. Remember, the objective of the trip is to gain information which will help you in your educational endeavors.
